Hong Kong-based British designer, Michael Young applied his talents to a diverse range of products this year. He designed an elegant collection comprising shelving, desk, and light. The new Hong Kong brand, EOQ, and launched a series of acoustic and decorative textile products for Australian company Wovin Image. His most interesting work, however, was Superclover by Lasvit. Superclover is an ingenious lighting system in which a single glass unit is attached to a geometric steel frame to create endless compositions.

Michael Anastassiades String Lights Flos

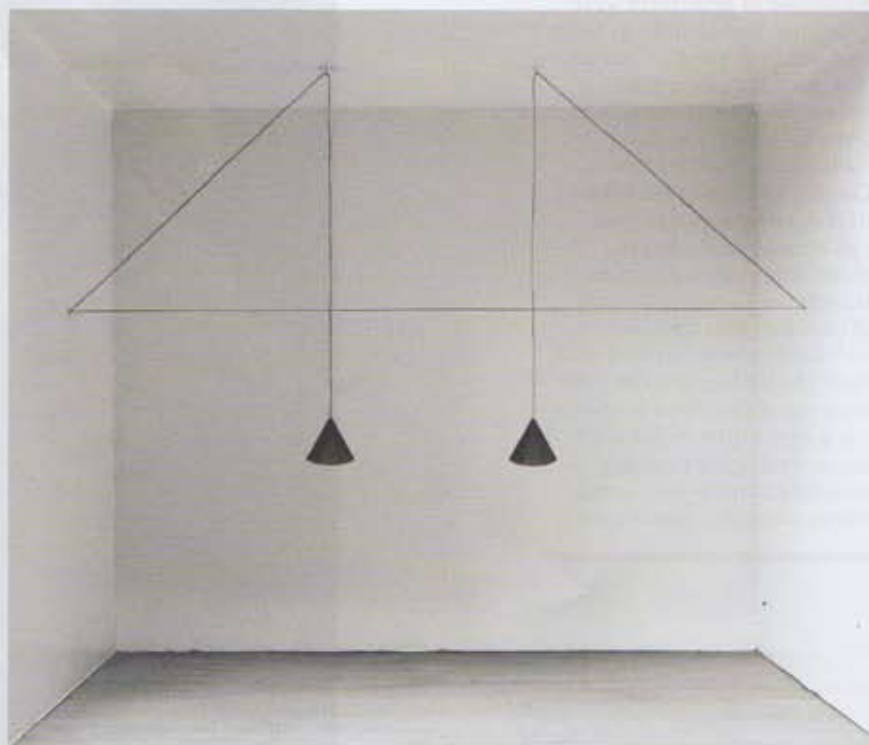
Italian lighting superbrand, Flos, launched a host of new products during Euroluce, including collaborations with Michael Anastassiades, Marc Newson, Paul Cockledge, and Rodolfo Dordoni. String Light by Anastassiades comprises two simple pendant lights, one spherical, the other an isosceles triangle, strung in pairs on long black electric wires. The installation at Euroluce showed the luminaires in graphic configurations, the wires forming a secondary architecture within the interior space. Anastassiades also exhibited his own brand in a separate booth at Euroluce, and showed a stunning marble installation at Wallpaper* Handmade.

Daniel Rybakken

Ascent
Luceplan

Over the past three years at Milan, Norwegian designer Daniel Rybakken's body of work has developed in a sophisticated and cohesive way. Particularly notable are his ethereal installations at Spazio Rosanna Orlandi in 2011 and 2012. Lighting and the way it affects the surrounding environment and those in it is clearly Rybakken's forte. This year he launched Ascent with Luceplan, a lamp that adapts the archetypal head from Counterbalance, the designer's first collaboration with the company. Users intuitively adjust light intensity and spread by moving the head up or down the slender stem.
